sector or about the sector. Those nominated do not have to be Guild members (though people nominating them must be), but they must be someone who has done an excellent job communicating with or to the rural sector, or on behalf of the rural sector.

There are three different sections, People, Production, Nature and Landscape and you can enter one or all. Remember, there is a discount for prompt payment if it is paid before 31 March. The subs are \$150 a year, or \$130 if paid by 31 March.
